## Care Giver Instructions

- 1. Check the transmitter everyday with the tester provided. Sign and date the tester sheet.
- 2. If a problem exists with the bracelet, the transmitter, or the battery notify us right away at 317-919-4993 or 317-919-4994.
- 3. If the transmitter is not indicating transmission (no pulsing or alternating red light), notify the Project Lifesaver Coordinator *immediately*.
- 4. If the client is missing, first check obvious places around your home. If not located, CALL 911!
  - a. If at home, give the 911 operator your address and advise them that your loved one is a Project Lifesaver Client equipped with an electronic transmitter.
  - b. If you are not at home, inform the 911 operator that your loved one is a Project Lifesaver client, and then provide the operator his or her name and their last known location. Provide a telephone number where you may be reached if you become disconnected. *Note:* Some dispatch agencies outside of Morgan County may not be familiar with the program.
  - c. After calling 911 call the agency coordinator at: 317-919-4993 or 317-919-4994.
